Sufi Dance Workshop in Kindergarten

The Kindergarten invited in a lady who does Sufi dancing for a workshop on Thursday. Sufi whirling (or Sufi turning) is a form of Sama or physically active meditation which originated among Sufis. It is a customary meditation practice performed within the Sema, or worship ceremony, through which dervishes aim to reach the source of all perfection, or kemal. This is sought through listening to the music, focusing on God, and spinning one's body in repetitive circles, which has been seen as a symbolic imitation of planets in the Solar System orbiting the sun.
